Our Team

Our school nursing service is part of 0 to 19 Torbay and works in partnership with parents, school staff, GPs, health visitors, Children's Services and other agencies to support your child's health and well-being.

If at any time you or your child's teacher have concerns, additional health assessments can be arranged with your agreement. We also support children and young people where families have decided to home educate.

Our Services

Starting school is an exciting time for children and their parents. It can be a daunting time too. With a little preparation and encouragement, most children will settle in easily at school; ready to learn and have fun in this new chapter of their lives.

Our School Nurse Team can provide general health and wellbeing advice, support, signposting with the following and provide a health care plan if required.

- Asthma
- Allergies
- Behaviour
- Constipation
- Diet / nutrition
- Eczema
- Emotional- health and wellbeing

- Hearing
- Sleep
- Toileting, day or night-time wetting, constipation
- Long term or complex medical needs
- Regular medication

We also offer specialist advice and support to parents, carers and school staff for children with medical needs such as asthma and severe allergies.

National Childhood Measurement Programme

The NHS needs to have a good understanding of how children are growing across the country, so that the best possible health services can be provided for them. As a result, a National Child Measurement Programme has been set up to weigh and measure children in England in Reception and Year 6. You will be sent a letter and information about the programme when your child's class is due to take part. You are given the option of opting out of this programme if you wish.



All parents/carers will be informed of the results of their child's measurements within two weeks of the measurement date.

If you have any general health concerns that might impact your child starting school, please contact us.
