
Engagement Scale - Example T

When T is least engaged, he vocalises

1. Least Engaged

continually and paces around the space he is in. He will find a book to flick and repeatedly flick the book with one hand turning the book



2. Partly Engaged

When T is partly engaged, he will, for example, seek out food, eat food readily available and at the same time walk to and froe. T will intermittently tap his head and hum.

3. Most Engaged

When T is most engaged, he will use eye gaze to make requests. He will remain quiet, watching or tracking and only vocalising to express pleasure or requesting a repetition/more of an activity. T will reach for something or gain attention by banging a surface.
